As another year comes to a close, we take this opportunity to thank those who have assisted the Board of Directors in making living in our community an enjoyable experience. We look forward to 2025.

Windy Garbage Days:

When putting out garbage and recycling, please make sure it is secured from being blown away during this windy, winter season. Loose garbage and recycling items become problematic when it ends up in the streets, neighbour's yards, and the creek. Some residents spend several hours each spring cleaning this up. This can be avoided by ensuring all garbage and recycling items are secured.



Snow Removal:

The snow removal crew will be onsite to clear the snow on our streets, driveways and walkways when there is more than 5 cm (2 inches) accumulation of snow. When needed, salt will be applied on the roadways. Keep in mind, salting becomes ineffective at extremely low temperatures. Residents are responsible for ice control on their own driveways and walkways. It is recommended to use a concrete friendly de-icer.

When major snowfall occurs, excess snow may have to be piled in our visitor parking areas. Therefore, we ask that you ensure your vehicles or those belonging to your guests are not parked in these areas during these times.

Holiday Decorations:

All holiday decorations and lighting are to be removed by **January 15th**.
