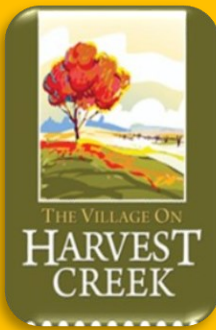


# Harvest Creek Community Update

## Public engagement workshop for the St. Davids roundabout:

Niagara Region has started the detailed design for the reconstruction of York Road (Regional Road 81) and Four Mile Creek Road (Regional Road 100) in Niagara-on-the-Lake into a single-lane roundabout.

The design of the roundabout and boulevards along York Road will allow for a unique streetscaping opportunity. The landscaping and height elements in the central island will add a focal point for St. Davids.
