

Coyotes in Harvest Creek- Be prepared, not scared.



In recent weeks there have been a few coyote sightings in Harvest Creek, even during daylight. Late January to mid February is mating season, so that may be the reason they are more visible. We ask that everyone be aware, especially those who walk their pets. Consider having a coyote safety kit, in the rare event that you have an encounter with a coyote. Candidate Election Signs:

Should residents wish to show their support for a candidate in the upcoming Provincial Election, they can place their candidate's sign in their front window only. Election signs are not permitted in the front gardens or on the front lawns. Signs must be removed by February 28, 2025, the day after the election.
